OUR FACILITIES

The three-storey building which houses Camp Auchtembeddie offers comfortable accommodation with all the amenities of modern living. The property is fully fenced and gated with external lights for security.

- Private lavatories and showers on each floor, and urinals for men
- Fully-equipped kitchen
- Spacious dining/multi-purpose room

ABOUT AUCHTEMBEDDIE DISTRICT

Auchtembeddie is a small agricultural district in Northern Manchester, close to the parish border with St. Elizabeth and Trelawny. Sited on hilly terrain some 339 metres (1,112.2 feet) above sea level, the district is about 60 miles from Jamaica's capital city, Kingston, and some 45 minutes from the thriving mid-island town of Mandeville.



BRIEF HISTORY CAMP AUCHTEMBEDDIE

Camp Auchtembeddie is owned and operated by The Diocese of Jamaica & The Cayman Islands (Anglican).

The facility was previously operated as a primary school. However, the institution was closed by the Ministry of Education in 2015 because of its low student population, among other factors. The Diocese subsequently upgraded and converted the property to accommodate the growing number of youth who attend its annual Summer Camps.
